The Greenhouse project is where you assist with the process of planting, growing and caring for bedding plants.

What is involved?

The Greenhouse project is based within our two Acorn Nursery Greenhouses. You will learn how to pot and label plug plants during our small group sessions, ready for sale to the public. You will assist with plant maintenance, ensuring they are regularly watered, deadheaded, weeded and moved into larger trays.

It is important to Acorn that we reuse as much as possible, so you will also assist with the cleaning and preparing of trays, ready to be used again next season.

What skills are learned?

- Increasing knowledge of plant names and general plant knowledge
- · Planting, pruning and watering techniques
- Preparing pots with compost, ready for planting plug plants
- Potting and labelling plants correctly
- Understanding propagation techniques
- Developing customer service skills and assisting the public with plant queries.
