



What is it?

The Reuse project is where donated items are received and then sorted into usable quality products which are then sold in the Acorn Reuse Centre in Trinity.

What is involved?

The Reuse project is based over two sites: La Collette and the Acorn Reuse Centre in Trinity. At La Collette, unwanted goods are received, packed and sent up to Acorn. Once at Acorn, items are sorted, cleaned and safety-tested. Some items are also distributed to other charities.

What skills are learned?

- Identifying products that are damaged and fail health and safety standards
- Working within a small team to help sort and price items
- Assembling pieces of furniture and building flat-packed items
- Steaming, sizing and pricing clothing, shoes and accessories
- Assisting with the sorting and pricing of books, DVDs, games etc
- Helping to tidy, sort and restock the reuse shop area.
